This document is a structured template for writing an Editorial Article.

FONT

The preferred file format is a Microsoft Word document. Please use 12 pt Arial or Times New Roman fonts throughout. Line spacing should be 1.5 or 2. There should be a space between each paragraph/bullet point.

TITLE PAGE

Title: maximum 200 characters

Authors: include those who have contributed intellectually and practically. For all authors please include first name, middle initial (if appropriate) and last name.

Institutions: primary and affiliated institutions, including Department, Institution, City and Country.

Corresponding author: include first name, middle initial (if appropriate), last name, postal address (including Department, Institution, City and Country) and e-mail address. Also include the telephone number and fax number for the corresponding author.

Keywords: 3-5 keywords

Running head: 60 characters maximum

ABSTRACT

Not required

BODY OF TEXT

The word limit is 800-1000 words. Editorials are generally viewpoint articles that will provide new information or opinions from acknowledged experts, and can be more subjective, forward-looking, or speculative. Re-tabulations of the existing literature, without insightful discussion and analysis, is discouraged. Most Editorials will be solicited by the Editors. However, we also welcome timely, unsolicited submissions. Editorials should be structured with an Introduction and Conclusion, but do not necessarily need subheadings.
